

To achieve level 5 or above in the 'Explore' level pupils must begin to:

*Research, select and evaluate assets from a range of digital sources, **justifying and referencing your sources***

In terms of referencing sources, in ICT we use a simple system to get pupils to do this. The table below is an example.

In terms of **justifying** their sources, this could form part of the end of unit evaluation or pupils could include another column in the table to do this. In this case it is best that the pupil creates a table in a separate document, and in landscape, to accommodate the comments they may add. An example can be seen below.
